Section 3 – Privacy Statement

Privacy Statement Your information is being collected for the purpose of processing your application. Your information is handled in accordance with the Information Privacy Act 2009 and will be accessed by persons who have been authorised to do so. Your information will not be given to any other person or agency unless you have given Council permission to or the disclosure is required by law.

Section 4 – Cat Control Laws – Animal Management

Registration: A person shall not keep a cat over three (3) months on a premise unless there is a current registration issued by Council in respect of such Cat. Registrations for all Cats are effective from 1st July to 30th June each financial year.

Animals must be under effective control: A person must not bring or permit an animal to be brought into a public place unless the animal is under the person's effective control. If an animal in a public place is not under effective control, an authorized person may seize and impound the animal.

Person in charge of Cat to clean up Cat faeces: If a Cat defecates in a public place, the person in charge of the Cat must immediately remove and dispose of the faeces in a sanitary manner.

Duty to provide proper enclosure: A person who keeps an animal must maintain a proper enclosure to keep the animal on the person's land and to prevent the animal from wandering or escaping from the land.

Duty to avoid nuisances: A person must not keep an animal on land if:

- The animal causes a nuisance; or
- The animal exposes the health or safety of others a significant risk;
- The animal creates a reasonable apprehension in the mind of others or threat to human safety.
